1. Important Information about Quantum Group and this Privacy Policy

Purpose of this Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy aims to give you the information on how Quantum Group collects and

processes your personal data in relation to Quantum Group's Services, including any data

you may provide when you: enter into a contract with us for a product, a service or a training

course; attend one of our events; contact us; fill in any of our forms on Quantum's website;

or enter into a contract with us as a Customer, a Learner, or an independent Contractor.

It is important that you read this Privacy Policy together with any other privacy policy or privacy

notice that we may provide on specific occasions when we are collecting or processing

personal data about you so that you are fully aware of how and why we are using your data.

This Privacy Policy is supplemental to any other notice and policy that we may give to you and

neither are intended to override or exclude the other.

We only collect data relating to individuals who are aged 16 to 18 for providing our training

course services, in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Except as provided before, Quantum

Group's Services are not intended for individuals under the age of 18.

2. The data we collect about you

Personal data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

We may collect, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data about you, when we enter into a contract together relating to one of Quantum's Services. We have grouped together the types of data we may collect, as follows:

- **Identity Data** may include your first name, last name, title, date of birth, gender and in certain circumstances, photo identity documents and national insurance number;
- Contact Data may include billing address, delivery address, email address and telephone numbers.
- Financial Data includes bank account and payment card details.
- **Transaction Data** includes details about payments to and from you and other details of products, services and training courses you have purchased from us.
- Technical Data includes internet protocol (IP) address, your login data, browser type
 and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions,
 operating system and platform, and other technology on the devices you use to
 access the website.
- Profile Data. Includes your username and password, purchases or orders made by you, your interests, preferences, feedback and survey responses.
- Usage Data includes information about how you use our website, our products, services and training courses.
- Marketing and Communications Data includes your preferences in receiving marketing from us and our third parties and your communication preferences.
- Special Category Data includes information about your health, and any disability that would require us to make reasonable adjustments for training delivery.

3. How your personal data is collected

We use different methods to collect data from and about you including through:

Direct Interactions. You may give to us your Identity Data, Contact Data and Financial Data

(in certain circumstances) when you:

• enter into a contract with us, to receive as a Customer a product or a service, or to

receive as a Learner a training course, and (if applicable) in your engagement as a

Contractor;

make an enquiry regarding our products, services, or training courses;

make an enquiry as to joining us as an independent Contractor;

fill in any of our forms on our website;

correspond with us in person, by post, by phone, by email or by other electronic

means;

sign-up or subscribe to receive our communications or publications;

request marketing to be sent to you;

attend an online or offline event organised by us, or an event organised by another

organisation where Quantum Group's delegates or representatives will be in

attendance;

enter into a competition, promotion or survey; and

give us feedback or contact us.

Automated technologies or interactions. As you interact with Quantum Group's website,

we will automatically collect Technical Data about your equipment, browsing actions and

patterns.

4. Which lawful bases we rely on to process your personal data

We will only use your personal data when the law allows us to. Most commonly, we will use

your personal data in the following circumstances:

Where we need to perform the contract we are about to enter into or have entered

into with you.

- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal obligation.

Generally, we do not rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your personal data although, we will get your consent before sending third party direct marketing communications to you via email or text message.

You have the right to withdraw consent to marketing at any time by contacting us.

If you fail to provide personal data

Where we need to collect personal data by law, or under the terms of a contract we have with you, we may not be able to perform a contract with you (for example to provide a product or a service, or any other agreement), if you fail to provide data when requested. In this case, we may have to cancel the relevant contract you have with us, but we will notify you if this is the case at the time. In certain circumstances we may also be prevented from complying with our legal obligations.

Change of purpose

Please note that Quantum Group will only use your personal data for the purpose that it was

originally collected, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another reason

and that reason is compatible with the original purpose. If you wish to get an explanation as

to how the processing for the new purpose is compatible with the original purpose, please

contact us, you can find Quantum Group's contact details above (page 3) or by clicking here.

We may process your personal data without your knowledge or consent, in compliance with

the above rules and where this is required or permitted by law.

Marketing

We strive to provide you with choices regarding certain personal data uses, particularly

around marketing and advertising as described below.

Promotional offers from us

We may use your Identity, Contact, Technical, Usage and Profile Data to form a view on

what we think you may want or need, or what may be of interest to you. This is how we

6. Data security

Quantum Group has put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal

data from being accidently lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or

disclosed. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those employees, agents,

contractors and third parties who have a legitimate business need to know. They will only

process your personal data on our instructions and they are subject to a duty of

confidentiality.

We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will

notify you and any regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

7. Data retention

How long will Quantum Group use my personal data for?

We will only retain your personal data for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfil the

purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, regulatory,

tax, accounting or reporting requirements. We may retain your personal data for a longer

period in the event of a complaint or if we reasonably believe there is a prospect of litigation

in respect to our relationship with you.

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount,

nature and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorised use

or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal data

and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal,

regulatory, tax, accounting or other requirements.

8. Your legal rights

Under certain circumstances you have rights under applicable data protection laws in

relation to your personal data, including the right to:

If you wish to exercise any of the rights set out above, please contact us.

No fee is usually required

You will not have to pay a fee to access your personal data (or to exercise any of the other

rights). However, we may charge a reasonable fee if your request is clearly unfounded,

repetitive or excessive. Alternatively, we could refuse to comply with the request in these

circumstances.

What we may need from you

We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and

ensure your right to access your personal information (or to exercise any of your rights). This

is a security measure to ensure that personal data is not disclosed to any person who has no

right to receive it. We may also contact you to ask you for further information in relation to

your request to speed up our response.

Time limit to respond

We try to respond to all legitimate requests within one month. Occasionally it could take us

longer than a month if your request is particularly complex or you have made a number of

requests. In this case, we will notify you and keep you informed.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

We reserve the right to update this Privacy Policy and/or the Annexes at any time, and we

will provide you with a new Privacy Policy and relevant Annex when we make any

substantial updates. We may also notify you in other ways from time to time about the

processing of your personal information.

9. Glossary

Legitimate Interest means the interest of our business in conducting and managing our

business to enable us to give you the best service/product and the best and most secure experience. We make sure we consider and balance any potential impact on you (both positive

and negative) and your rights before we process your personal data for our legitimate

interests. We do not use your personal data for activities where our interests are overridden by the impact on you (unless we have your consent or are otherwise required or permitted to

by law). You can obtain further information about how we assess our legitimate interests

against any potential impact on you in respect of specific activities by contacting us.

Performance of Contract means processing your data where it is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are a party or to take steps at your request before

entering into such a contract.

Comply with a legal obligation means processing your personal data where it is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation that we are subject to.

Your legal rights

You have the right to:

Request access to your personal data (commonly known as a "data subject access request"). This enables you to receive a copy of the personal data we hold about you and to check that we are lawfully processing it.

Request correction of the personal data that we hold about you. This enables you to have any incomplete or inaccurate data we hold about you corrected, though we may need to verify the accuracy of the new data you provide to us.

Request erasure of your personal data. This enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal data where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it. You also have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal data where you have successfully exercised your right to object to processing (see below), where we may have processed your information unlawfully or where we are required to erase your personal data to comply with local law. Note, however, that we may not always be able to comply with your request of erasure for specific legal reasons which will be notified to you, if applicable, at the time of your request.

Object to processing of your personal data where we are relying on a legitimate interest (or those of a third party) and there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground as you feel it impacts on your fundamental rights and freedoms. You also have the right to object where we are processing your personal data for direct marketing purposes. In some cases, we may demonstrate that we have compelling legitimate grounds to process your information which override your rights and freedoms.

Request restriction of processing of your personal data. This enables you to ask us to suspend the processing of your personal data in the following scenarios:

- If you want us to establish the data's accuracy.
- Where our use of the data is unlawful but you do not want us to erase it.
- Where you need us to hold the data even if we no longer require it as you need it to establish, exercise or defend legal claims.
- You have objected to our use of your data but we need to verify whether we have overriding legitimate grounds to use it.

Request the transfer of your personal data to you or to a third party. We will provide to you, or a third party you have chosen, your personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format.
